






JMikal Davis' Bay Street murals

JMikal Davis is a Brooklyn-based artist known for his unique style of abstract compositions that integrate ornate floral patterning, discordant colors, and sharp, fragmented geometry. His studio practice evolved out of a formal arts education and an early love of street art growing up in the South. Davis' aesthetic language fuses the contemporary and the traditional, reflecting both the minimalist deconstruction of Graffuturism movement in mural art, the Washington Color school, and the handmade, folk art style of the Mission School. In addition to gallery shows throughout the US and Europe, Davis continues his street practice with numerous large-scale murals and public commissions. JMikal Davis' Bay Street murals are located on the corridor entry from Level 3 of the parking garage, which leads to our brand-new Bay Break Dining Terrace and the corridor on Level 1 of the parking garage, which leads to Sephora.











Map of Sea Wall Murals




